



Care Tips for Pure Aniline Leathers

Pure aniline leathers do not have a protective coating applied to the surface and are therefore more susceptible to sunlight and are not recommended for furniture used by small children or for high traffic areas where food and drink could stain the leather. For these types of areas a semi aniline leather is preferred.

Try to maintain at least 60cm between your furniture and heating source. Prolonged exposure to heat vents or radiators will cause your leather to dry out.

Avoid placing your furniture in direct sunlight. All materials will fade over time when placed in direct sunlight. Pure aniline leathers are especially sensitive to sunlight.

As with all items in your house, leather can accumulate dust and it is recommended that you dust your furniture weekly. You may use the soft brush attachment on your vacuum. Leather allows you to remove dust particles from the surface, making it ideal for dust-sensitive people.

All leathers perform to a higher standard when preventative maintenance is practised.

Use proprietary leather cleaners and conditioners in strict accordance with manufacturers instructions.

IMPORTANT

Never use harsh chemicals or cleaning agents on your leather furniture. Avoid all products containing solvents or oils, as they will negatively effect the surface of the leather.
