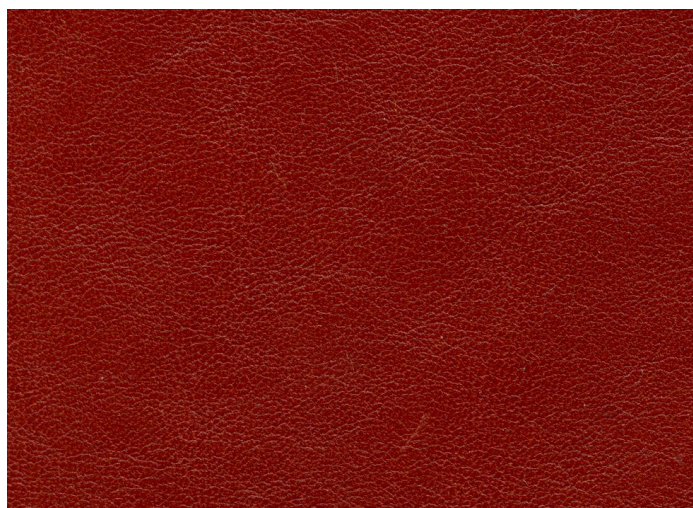
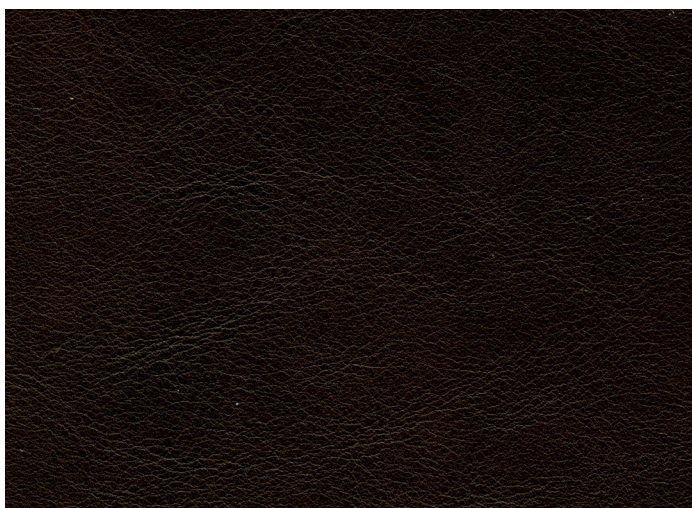


TAURUS

As a Pure Aniline TAURUS has an attractive sheen with a flat grain. Despite being a pure aniline this leather is suitable for saddles. TAURUS exhibits all the nature features such as scars, growth marks and fat wrinkles etc. Only the best European raw hides are chosen for our Pure Aniline leathers. TAURUS has no milling grain and is vacuum dried giving it a lustrous, luxurious appearance and feel.

TAURUS is suitable for both residential and commercial applications where comfort and appearance are paramount.

RAW MATERIALS

PRODUCTION

- Environmentally Improved Production Process: Use of water-based finishes, no hazardous substances such as azo dyes, organochlorine compounds, benzidine, pentachlorophenol (PCP), formaldehyde, hexavalent chromium, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), cadmium and chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) are used.

CARE

- Avoid placing leather in direct sunlight, weather and at least 60cm from heat source
- Do not use harsh chemicals, shoe polish, saddle soap or unidentified leather cleaners, solvents and oils
- Keep free of dust and grit. Dust before cleaning. If vacuuming use a soft attachment.
- Gently remove all spills immediately with a clean dry cloth (do not use damp cloth). Do not scrub or rub hard
- Regularly clean contact areas such as arms and head rests to avoid build up of perspiration and body oils, which may discolour leather,
- We recommend professional cleaning with specialist leather cleaners and conditioners in strict accordance with manufacturer's instructions
